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| Course summary/aims: (Might also be used for brochure or poster blurb) | Enjoy the opportunity to be creative whilst developing your sewing skills. Design and make a quilted item such as a wall hanging or table runner, using a number of different sewing techniques. |
| Course objectives: (There MUST be 5 for non-accredited Community Learning courses; this is not so essential for qualification-based courses) | By the end of the course you will be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select suitable fabric, wadding and thread for a quilt project 2. Create texture with fabric 3. Make a quilt sandwich 4. Apply quilt as you go techniques 5. Quilt by hand |
| Course content: | During the course you will explore different patchwork and quilting techniques, leading to the creation your own unique project. |
| Teaching and learning methods: | Tutor demonstrations, guided exercises, one to one and group discussions, peer group input. |
| Course level/entry requirements: | An ability to use needle and thread would be an advantage. The project may be hand sewn or made using a sewing machine. |
| How progress is checked during course: | Informal and supportive individual feedback from tutor. Self assessment, peer group discussion. |
| Extra study or practice required at home? | Simple tasks developing work started in class. |
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| Formal course accreditation? If yes, how is the course assessed? | N/A |
| Materials you will need to bring to the course: | Please bring your sewing kit (including scissors for cutting fabric). Some fabric and wadding will be provided, but you may also bring your own. Please bring your sewing machine if you wish. |
| What can I do next? | Attend another craft course such as machine sewn patchwork. |
