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| Course summary/aims:   | A nationally recognised, accredited Level 3 First Aid course suitable for the workplace and for at home.   |
| Course objectives:   | The objective of the qualification is to benefit Learners by enabling them to attain the knowledge and practical competencies needed to deal with a range of emergency first aid situations and/or take on the role of emergency first aider in the workplace. |
| Course content:  | Tutor lead course comprising of PowerPoint, practical application, Q&A and a written theory exam   |
| Teaching and learning methods:                                   | PowerPoint presentation, visual/audio Q&A, kinaesthetic - hands on skills required   |
| Course level/entry requirements:                                 | Numeracy - counting compression, etc.<br>Literacy - reading presentation + exam  |

| Formal course accreditation? If yes, how is the course assessed? | Yes, 3 practical skills, all marked via marking sheet and 1 theory exam  |
| Materials you will need to bring to the course:                  | Packed lunch, sensible clothes to allow movement/floor work  |
| What can I do next?  | Be a first-aider at work or in voluntary settings; undertake the longer 3 day QA Level 3 First Aid at Work (QCF) qualification; undertake related courses such as Food Safety or Health and Safety.  |
