

## FLRE

FLARE is a practical study programme for 16-18s that is built around your needs. It is designed to relate to the working world and you will develop your confidence and skills.

You can gain qualifications at Entry or Level 1 including:

Award in Skills for Employment and Further Learning English and Maths

Occupational tasters can include a wide range of possibilities - social care, retail, customer service, digital photography, painting and decorating, cooking, planning a trip - and much more!

On Flare, we also visit employers, have people come in to talk and go on trips. We explore many topics that students have chosen - including community projects, sport, camping and enterprise projects.

You will also have the opportunity for a work placement when you are ready. We help you move to the next step - whether this is further learning or employment.

Bridge-2-2 is for young people who need a bridging course to be able to apply successfully for apprenticeships and longer vocational courses at Level 2 or 3. It can include GCSE.

### Qualifications are mainly at Level 2:

Award in Skills for Employment and Further Learning English and Maths at Level 2 or GCSE.

As with FLARE, occupational tasters can involve many possibilities and we'll seek to adapt the programme to your interests.

On Bridge-2-2, we expect course members to develop a clear personal goal quite early in the course so that we can focus on your "bridge to success"!
